



1. When roads are slippery, you should:
Avoid making fast turns and stops.....
Make fast stops to test the traction of your tires.....
Decrease the distance that you look ahead of your vehicle.....
2. You have consented to take a test for the alcohol content of your blood, breath, or urine:
